

Rising Insane - Wildfires

The German band Rising Insane presents their fourth album, „Wildfires“, comprising 11 songs and 34 minutes of intense musical expression that takes the listener on an emotional rollercoaster. This journey is crafted through a fusion of powerful riffs and clean vocals

that alternate with potent growls, creating a captivating balance between brutality and melody.

Rising Insane have established themselves as a prominent band in the European metalcore scene, and „Wildfires“ reaffirms their standing in the genre. In this latest work, however, they go beyond metalcore, incorporating elements of post-hardcore, alternative metal, djent, and even subtle electronic influences, achieving an innovative and well-executed blend. Another essential aspect of „Wildfires“ lies in its lyrics, which delve into profound and relevant themes: inner struggles, depression, resilience, and the need to find light amid darkness.

This album reflects both the individual and collective growth of its members, achieving evolution in both sound and lyrical composition. Through sonic atmospheres that range from somber to explosive, alternating between clean tones and aggressive undertones, „Wildfires“ stands as a solid, emotive work that remains true to Rising Insane's style.
